- Remove existing back portion of Quonset: approximately 12 meters long, 9.8 meters wide and 8 meters tall;
- Remove existing back portion of Quonset in a safe manner;
- Logistically remove and properly dispose of the scrap materials;
- Utilize quality existing materials to frame and board remaining exposed back side of the Quonset;
- Finishing will include insulating and installing siding on the remaining back portion.
